Today's Date:

Topic Humpty Dumpty		Supplies
Language	<p>Read, "Mother Goose Nursery Rhymes"</p> <p>Discuss what you could do to put Humpty back together again.</p>	
Art	<p>Humpty Puzzle: Put Humpty back together with bandaids</p> <p>Make Humpty and glue him to brick wall, match bricks to there correct numbers</p> <p>Egg Splat Painting: Fill broken eggs with paint and drop them on to the paper!</p>	
Science <i>(STEM, Science, Technology, Engineering and Math)</i>	<p>Egg Science: Do eggs float?</p> <p>Real Life Humpty: Place a real egg on top of cardboard bricks and watch him fall! Place different types of material under the egg and observe whether the egg breaks or not</p>	

<p>Sensory</p>	<p>Play with plastic eggs in shredded paper, rice and popcorn kernels</p> <p>Place different materials inside plastic eggs and have the children guess whats inside. Discuss which eggs are quiet and which are loud.</p>	
<p>Music</p>	<p>Poor Humpty Dumpty Song sung to "Three Blind Mice"</p> <p>Poor Humpty Dumpty Poor Humpty Dumpty It's sad to tell He broke his shell! He hurried and scurried to the top of the wall He sat on the edge and had a great fall</p> <p>But he couldn't bound like a rubber ball Poor Humpty Dumpty!</p>	
<p>Dramatic Play</p>	<p>Humpty Dumpty Play: Use large plastic eggs with faces drawn on for Humpty Dumpty, horses, cardboard bricks for the wall, and a lego man too act out the rhyme</p>	

<p>Social Science <i>(diversity, community roles, decision making, geography, history, and ecology)</i></p>	<p>Discuss where the the rhyme originated and show the kids pictures of the originally Humpty Dumpty from “Alice through the Looking glass”</p>
